### Monthly Stipends and 3rd Sunday Collections

Thank you so much for your generosity to the Parish collections, for the warmth of your welcome, your encouragement, advice and support.

I was asked by a couple of Parishioners about how the monthly stipend now works. All Parish Priests are on a fixed salary and have been for many years now. My monthly salary is  $\pounds$ 1,562 (50% payable from Saul and 50% payable from Kilclief) and the monthly stipend collection goes towards paying that.

The 3 Special collections at Christmas, Easter and October (Autumn) goes towards making up that total in Parishes.

Now that there is only the one Priest covering both Parishes the excess goes to the central fund to make up that figure in the poorer Parishes.

I hope this answers any questions you may have and clarify where your contributions actually goes.

The details of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday collections will be put in the bulletin the previous week so that you know exactly where your contributions are going.

Please, never be afraid to ask me about anything in the Parish.
